## Local Law #1 of 2014

A Local Law authorizing contract with local food pantry to provide food to the needy of the Town.

### Section 1: Authority

This local law is enacted pursuant to the authority of Section 10 (1)(ii)(a)(12) of the Municipal Home Rule Law authorizing Towns to adopt a local law pursuant to its police powers authorizing the Town to sponsor a local food pantry, since it promotes the health, safety and well-being of persons within the Town of Westville.

### Section 2: Definitions

As used in the Local Law, the following terms shall have the meaning indicated:

- a) The Local Food Pantry shall be the Constable Food Pantry or its successor which provides food to the needy of the Town of Westville.

### Section 3: Contract

The Town Supervisor of the Town of Westville is hereby empowered to enter into a contract with the Local Food Pantry on an annual basis to operate a food pantry, servicing the needy of the Town in whatever amount that the Town Board has provided for this purpose in the annual town budget, which budget is subject to limitations on indebtedness and taxation applying to the Town under State Law.

### Section 4: Severability

If any part or provision of this Local Law shall for any reason be adjudged finally by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such judgment shall not affect, impair or invalidate the remainder of the Local Law, but shall be confined in its operation and effect to the cause, sentence, phrase, paragraph or part thereof directly involved in the controversy or action in which such judgment shall have rendered. It is hereby declared to be the legislative intent that the remainder of this Local Law would have been adopted had any such provision not been included.

### Section 5: Effective Date

The Local Law shall take effect immediately upon the filing with the New York State Secretary of State.

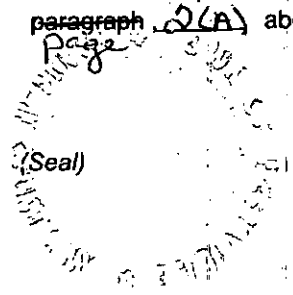
