

Town of Westville
Public Hearing Minutes (#1)

October 10, 2022

Rodrique Lauzon, Town Supervisor, opened the public hearing of the Town of Westville Town Board at 6:15 p.m. on October 10, 2022 at the Westville Town Hall.

Town Supervisor Lauzon asked everyone to please stand for the Pledge of Allegiance.

The Clerk of the Town of Westville Board, Ann Brady, called the roll.

Present at the hearing: Town Supervisor Rodrique Lauzon; Town Councilmen Sean Barnes; Deputy Supervisor, Brenda St. Hilaire; Code Enforcement Officer Robert Crossman and Highway Superintendent Kevin Nichols. Also present: Rosanna Clark and Sue Picard from FOTNC.

Supervisor Lauzon introduced Sue Picard from Friends of the North Country to the Board and indicated that she would be addressing the Board in regard to encouraging any community input on fair housing matters.

Sue Picard addressed the Board:

The Town of Westville is holding this Public Hearing to encourage citizen participation and input on fair housing matters in order to meet the requirements of NYS Homes and Community Renewal's Citizen Participation Plan.

As the Town of Westville was awarded a Community Development Block Grant for Manufactured Home Replacement Activities; Project #: 1243MH104-20, this public meeting was scheduled for community input on fair housing matters.

The total Grant Award is for \$500,000; of which \$410,000 is the capital amount. To date, the capital expended is \$365,607.50 and the total obligated is \$410,000. Original unit goal was 5; 4 have been completed and 1 is under construction. In addition, Friends of the North Country has leveraged an additional \$223,450.00.
